

YEAR 9 SECONDARY SCHOOL GRANT CRITERIA

- 1. Up to 10 Grants of \$500 (NZD) each to be awarded each year.
- 2. Year 9 means the year a student is starting their 9th year of education.
- 3. Grants are aimed at when a student commences Secondary School (Year 9).

 This may vary in some schools/countries but the grant will be for the year a student starts their 9th year of education.
- 4. Only one application per eligible student permitted.
- 5. Parent / Guardian of applicant must be a financial member (for 12 months) of Manchester Unity Friendly Society.
- 6. All applications must be on prescribed form (available from Lodge Office or Online) & verified by Fraternal Administrator / Lodge Secretary.
- 7. Applications to close 30th November each year.
- 8. All forms must be received at Head Office by 30 November each year.
- 9. The ballot is conducted at Head Office under instructions from the Fraternal Council, in mid December.
- 10. All applicants will be advised in writing if successful or not by end of December.
- 11. A letter to the unsuccessful applicants will also be sent by end December.
- 12. In cases of Hardship an application for assistance can be made by the Parent / Guardian of the applicant through their Fraternal Administrator / Lodge Secretary to the SBERF Fund for further consideration.
