

EDUCATION GRANT CRITERIA

1. Education Grants are aimed at when a student commences Secondary School (Year 9)
2. Year 9 means the year a student is starting their ninth year of education
3. Up to 10 Grants of \$500 (NZD) each to be awarded each year
4. Only one application per eligible student permitted
5. Parent/Guardian of applicant must hold a financial product (for 12 months) of Manchester Unity Friendly Society. This may include a funeral benefit, medical insurance or kickstart.
6. All applications must be on the attached Education Grant Application form
7. Applications to close 30th November each year
8. Applications must be received at the address provided by 10th December each year
9. The ballot for successful applicants will be held in December
10. All applicants will be advised in writing if successful or not by end of December.
